Membership

All bowlers must be USBC Youth members in good standing for the 2024/2025 season. At least **one** bowler must be a 2024/2025 Elite 8 Series Member.

USBC memberships (\$4) and Elite 8 Series Membership (\$20) may be purchased on-site.

Entry Fee / Deadline Date

Entry Fee is \$60:

\$24 lineage, \$26 scholarships, and \$10 awards/expenses.

The early registration deadline is November 3, 2024. Early entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full payment. Entries/Payment received after the deadline will have a \$10 late fee. All late fees will be added to the scholarship fund.

On-Site Registration

Will be allowed on a first come, first served basis, and will be subject to a \$5 late fee, per bowler. Late fee will **not** apply to re-entries.

On-site registration will close 30 minutes before squad times.
(CASH or ZELLE ONLY)

Divisions and Handicap

2 Divisions based on team average:

319 & below

320 & up

Handicap will be based on 90% from 200

Average Verification

- A. Elite 8 tournament average of 9 games or more, as of October 21, 2024.
- B. If A does not apply, use 2023/24 Composite Average as listed on Bowl.com
- C. If A& B do not apply, use the highest 9 game, certified league average as of October 27, 2024 (Include league standing sheet with entry)
- D. If none of the above apply, bowler will use a 200 average.

Scholarship Fund

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558)

Format

Teams will consist of 2 Youth bowlers (under 18 as of Aug 1, 2024). **Partner must change if bowling both squads.**

Bowlers will bowl 3 standard games, staying on their original pair.

The lane condition will be a house pattern.

Bowling Ball Specifications

Alteration of the ball surface may be performed before or during practice only. Balls must be drilled and maintained within USBC guidelines only.

Dress Code / Conduct

Collared shirts or bowling jerseys are required.

Shorts & skorts must be at least fingertip length.

Clothing with holes, tight spandex, head gear, or sunglasses will not be permitted. Any exceptions for dress code must be approved by tournament officials.

In order to verify dress code, all bowlers **MUST** check themselves in.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to striking ball return or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in immediate disqualifications and forfeiture of fees paid. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler settee area. Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

Bonus Scholarship Raffle
