# Denton County USBC Baker Doubles

1. **Tournament date: June 6, 2026. Tournament entry closing date: May 28, 2026 (Thursday)**  
Entry form may be turned in to any DCUSBC Board Member by May 28, 2026 or postmarked no later than 05-29-26. Late entries accepted with an additional \$10 fee per person until 10pm on June 5<sup>th</sup>.  
Tournament is open to all Denton County USBC members. DCUSBC local membership may be purchased for \$10.
2. **Entry may consist of any two bowlers.** You may enter both squads, but must change partner. Teams will bowl four games. Bowlers will bowl every other frame. Bowlers will decide at the end of practice who will start all 4 games. The same bowler will start all 4 games.
3. **Average** to be used for this tournament shall be (in priority listed below):
  - a. Highest **2024-25** Denton County USBC Book Average (Fall)
  - b. Highest **2025-2026** Denton County USBC Average of 21 games or more as of 05-22-2025
  - c. Highest **2025** Summer Denton County USBC Average of 21 games or more
  - d. Highest average from bowl.com of 21 games or more for 2024-2025 (Summer or Fall)

## **No entries will be allowed with combined average over 220. (Averages of both bowlers added together & divided by 2)**

**\*\*Bowlers are responsible for providing verification of their own averages whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others (Rule 319-3) Incorrect averages are subject to disqualification. (Rule 319a (2), 319d and 319e are waived**

4. **Handicap** for this tournament will be 90% of the difference between entering average and 220. Averages of both bowlers to be added together, divided by 2, then 90% from 220.
5. Any bowler arriving late or leaving early will receive zero for all frames missed.
6. Practice will be 10 minutes. Bowlers will throw one ball and move to the back of the line without resetting the pins.
7. Prize fund will be returned 100%, at least one (1) place for every seven (7) entries. In case of a tie for any position, place money for all tied positions will be combined and divided equally. Prize money will be distributed within 30 days of the close of the tournament.
8. Tournament scores may not be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager when scores are irretrievably lost due to malfunction of an automatic scoring device.
9. No entry will be accepted without entry fee attached. Cash will not be accepted.
10. Substitutes will be allowed, if eligible, but no refunds after entry closing date. Report all subs as quickly as possible.
11. USBC rules shall govern this tournament in addition to the rules adopted by the Denton County USBC Tournament Rules Committee which shall decide any questions not covered by these Tournament Rules.

The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Denton County USBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when those entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Denton County USBC, Inc.
