## DCUSBC/Elite 8 Series Youth Open Tournament

#### Membership

All bowlers must be USBC Youth members in good standing for the 2025/2026 season.

Bowlers do not need to be 2025/2026 Elite 8 Series Members.

#### **Elite 8 Members**

All games will count towards your E8 average.
E8 Series Points & Automatic Entries to Finals will be given for
E8 members for the team and singles events.
Join E8 by 11:59pm, November 16<sup>th</sup> to earn points.

#### **Entry Fee / Deadline Date**

Team Entry Fee is \$90 (\$30 per person), Singles fee is \$30 per person.

Optional All-Events is \$10 per person.

For each 3-game set, the fee breakdown per person is: \$12 linage, \$13 scholarships, and \$5 awards/expenses The entire \$10 fee for All-Events will go to scholarships.

The early registration deadline is November 9, 2025. Early entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full payment. Entries/Payment received after the deadline will incur a \$5 late fee per person. All late fees will be added to the scholarships for Team & Singles.

#### **On-Site Registration**

Will be allowed on a first come, first served basis and will be subject to the late fee - \$5 per person.

Re-entries will not be subject to the late fee.

On-site registration will close 30 minutes before squad times.

(CASH or ZELLE ONLY)

#### **Divisions and Handicap**

Team, Singles, All-Events will have one division each.

Team Handicap is 90% from 600

Singles/All-Events will be 90% from 200

#### **Average Verification**

- A. Official Elite 8 tournament average (9 games or more) as of October 20, 2025.
  - B. If A does not apply, use 2024/25 Composite Average as listed on Bowl.com
  - C. If A & B do not apply, use the highest 9 game certified league average as of November 2, 2025 (include league standing sheet with entry)

Converted sport shot average will be used if no bowl.com house average is available

If none of the above apply, bowler will bowl using a 200 average

#### ormat

Singles Event - Bowlers will bowl 3 standard games

Team Event - 3 bowlers, each bowling 3 standard games

All-Events - Scores will be the 6-game total from your Team and Singles events.

The lane condition will be a house pattern

Bowlers can enter just the Team Event, just the Singles Event, or both. Bowlers who enter both are eligible to enter All-Events. Must enter All-Events before beginning the Singles event.

#### **Scholarship Fund**

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558)

#### **Bowling Ball Specifications**

Alteration of the ball surface may be performed before or during practice only. Balls must be drilled and maintained within USBC guidelines only.

#### **Dress Code / Conduct**

#### Collared shirts or bowling jerseys are required.

Shorts & skorts must be at least fingertip length.

Clothing with holes, tight spandex, head gear, or sunglasses will not be permitted. Any exceptions for dress code must be approved by tournament officials.

In order to verify dress code, all bowlers MUST check themselves in.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to: striking ball return or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in immediate disqualifications and forfeiture of fees paid. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler settee area. Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

#### **Junior Gold Qualifier**

This tournament will run an optional Junior Gold Qualifier with on-site registration. Bowlers **must** also be entered in the 2025 DCUSBC Youth Open. More information to come.

#### **Bonus Scholarship Raffle**

Please bring a new, unwrapped toy for donation to Toys for Tots.

All bowlers who bring in at least one item will be entered into an extra \$50 scholarship raffle. One entry per bowler. There will be one drawing with the combined bowlers from both squads.
