Membership

All bowlers must be 2025/26 USBC Youth members in good standing AND at least one bowler must be a 2025/26 Elite 8 Member.

Memberships can be purchased at the time of entry or onsite.
USBC Youth memberships are \$4.
Elite 8 Memberships are \$20.

Entry Fee / Deadline Date

Entry Fee is \$60:

\$24 lineage, \$31 scholarships, and \$5 awards/expenses
The early registration deadline is October 12th, 2025. Early entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full payment.
Entries/Payment received after the deadline will have a \$5 late fee per person. All late fees will be added to the scholarship fund.

On-Site Registration

Will be allowed on a first come, first served basis.
On-site registration will close 30 minutes before squad times.
Re-Entries will **not** be charged the late fee.
(CASH or ZELLE ONLY)

Divisions and Handicap

1 Division

Individual averages will be added together and the Doubles Handicap will be 90% from 400

Average Verification

- A. Elite 8 tournament average of 9 games or more, as of September 29, 2025.
 - B. If A does not apply, use 2024/25 Composite Average of 9 games or more as listed on Bowl.com
 - C. If A & B do not apply, use the highest 9 game, certified league average as of October 5, 2025 (Include league standing sheet with entry)
 - D. If none of the above apply, bowler will use a 200 average.
- (Converted sport shot average will be used if no bowl.com house average is available)

Scholarship Fund

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558)

Bowling Ball Specifications

Alteration of the ball surface may be performed before or during practice only. Balls must be drilled and maintained within USBC guidelines only.

Doubles Tournament Format

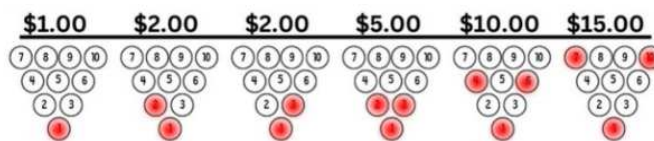
Teams will consist of 2 Youth bowlers (under 18 as of Aug 1, 2025). **Partner must change if bowling both squads.**

Bowlers will bowl 3 conventional games, staying on their original pair. The lane condition will be a house pattern.

Tournament winners are based on the 6-game handicap series.

The lanes will be re-oiled between squads.

Bonus Color Pin Scholarships - Singles



When a bowler has any of the above color pin configurations, they have a chance to win the listed scholarship amounts.

The number of pins they need to knock down on their *FIRST* ball will be based on the bowler's tournament average:
94 and below – knock down 4 or more pins on the first ball
95-124 – knock down 6 or more pins on the first ball
125 – 174 – knock down 8 or more pins on the first ball
175 and up – must bowl a strike

Bonus funds will be given to individuals based on their performance, not combined between doubles partners.

Scholarships for color pin splits conversions or spares with *only* color pins will be at the discretion of the tournament officials.

Dress Code / Conduct

Collared shirts or bowling jerseys are required.

Shorts, skorts, and skirts must be at least fingertip length.
Clothing with holes, tight spandex, head gear, or sunglasses will not be permitted. Any exceptions for dress code must be approved by tournament officials.

To verify dress code, all bowlers **MUST** check themselves in.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to: striking ball return or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in immediate disqualifications and forfeiture of fees paid. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler settee area.

Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify bowlers for infractions of the rules, misbehavior, or actions detrimental to the procedure of this tournament.
