Membership

All bowlers must be USBC members in good standing and Adults must be Denton County USBC members. Both 2025/26 and 2026/27 memberships will be accepted. Youth may purchase 2026/27 membership for \$4. Adults may purchase USBC memberships for \$25 or the Denton County local only membership for \$10.

Youth bowlers need to be Elite 8 Members.

Memberships can be purchased with entry or on-site.

Entry Fee

Entry Fee is \$50 per team.
\$24 linage, \$21 scholarships, and \$5 awards/expenses

Entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full payment.

No Late fees for this tournament.

Divisions and Handicap

One division
Handicap is 80% from 440

Average Verification

A. **Youth:** E8 tournament average of 9 games or more as of July 1, 2026

Adult: Highest 2025/2026 DCUSBC Book (fall) Average

B. If A does not apply, use 2025/26 Composite Average (**youth** 9+ games, **adults** 21+ games) as listed on Bowl.com

C. If A & B do not apply, **youth & adult** will use the highest 9 game, certified league average as of July 26, 2026.

D. If A – C do not apply, and the **adult** bowler has an E8 tournament average of 9 games or more as of July 1, 2026, they will use that.

E. If none of the above apply, bowler (**youth and adult**) will use a 220 average.

Converted sport shot average will be used if no Bowl.com house average is available.

On-Site Registration

Will be allowed on a first come, first served basis

On-site registration will close 30 minutes before squad times.
(CASH or ZELLE ONLY)

Format

Teams will consist of 1 Youth bowler and 1 Adult bowler. Bowlers will bowl three 9 Pin No Tap games, staying on their original pair.

If 9 pins are knocked down on the first ball, the bowler will receive a strike.

The youth and adult scores will be added together for a doubles total.

The lane condition will be a house pattern.

Partner must change if bowling both squads.

Scholarship Fund

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558)

Dress Code

Shorts, skorts, and skirts must be at least fingertip length.

The following will not be permitted:

Tank tops, clothing with holes, tight spandex, headgear, or sunglasses.

Attire depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, illegal substances, or inappropriate language/gestures may not be worn in accordance with Rule 301b.

Any exceptions to the dress code must be approved by tournament officials.

To verify the dress code, all bowlers **MUST** check themselves in.

Conduct

Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

Optional Side Events

Denton County USBC will provide optional side events. Youth can earn extra SMART funds and adults can earn cash. Zelle & Cash will be accepted.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify bowlers for infractions of the rules, misbehavior, or actions detrimental to the procedure of this tournament.
