Membership

All bowlers must be 2025/2026 USBC members in good standing and Adults must be Denton County USBC members. Youth may purchase 25/26 membership for \$4. Adults may purchase 25/26 USBC memberships for \$25 or the Denton County local only membership for \$10 (must already have a 25/26 USBC membership).

Youth Bowlers must be 25/26 season Elite 8 Members. Elite 8 Membership is \$20.

Memberships can be purchased with entry or on-site.

Entry Fee / Deadline Date

Entry Fee is \$50 per team.

\$16 linage, \$29 scholarships, and \$5 awards/expenses
The early registration deadline is December 7th, 2025.
Early entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full
payment. Entries/Payment received after the deadline will have
a \$5 per-person late fee. All late fees will be added to the
scholarship fund. Bowlers re-entering will not be subject to the
late fee.

On-Site Registration

Average Verification

A. **Youth**: E8 tournament average of 9 games or more as of November 17, 2025

Adult: Highest 2024/2025 DCUSBC Book (fall) Average

- B. If A does not apply, use 2024/25 Standard Composite Average (Youth 9 games or more, Adults 21 games or more) as listed on Bowl.com
 - C. If A& B do not apply, use the highest 9 game, certified league average as of November 30, 2025 (Include league standing sheet with entry)
 - D. If A, B, & C do not apply, and the **Adult** bowler has an E8 tournament average of 9 games or more as of November 17, 2025, they will use that.
 - E. If none of the above apply, bowler (youth and adult) will use a 210 average.

Converted sport shot average will be used if no Bowl.com house average is available.

Scholarship Fund

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558)

Format

Teams will consist of 1 Youth bowler (under 18 as of Aug 1, 2025) and 1 Adult bowler.

Partner must change if bowling both squads.

Bowlers will bowl 4 team baker games, staying on their original pair.

Baker Format – partners will take turns bowling *frames* within one game.

The lower average bowler will start all games and bowl frames 1-3-5-7-9.

The higher average bowler will bowl frames 2-4-6-8-10. If bowlers have the same average, the team will decide (at the end of practice) which bowler will start all the games. The lane condition will be a house pattern.

Bowling Ball Specifications

Alteration of the ball surface may be performed before or during practice only. Balls must be drilled and maintained within USBC guidelines only.

Dress Code / Conduct

Collared shirts or bowling jerseys are required.

Shorts & skorts must be at least fingertip length.
Clothing with holes, tight spandex, head gear, or sunglasses will not be permitted. Any exceptions for dress code must be approved by tournament officials.
In order to verify dress code, all bowlers MUST check themselves in.

Attire depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, illegal substances, or inappropriate language/gestures may not be worn in accordance with Rule 301b.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to striking ball return or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in immediate disqualifications and forfeiture of fees paid. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler settee area. Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify bowlers for infractions of the rules, misbehavior, or actions detrimental to the procedure of this tournament.
