Youth Alibi Doubles Tournament

Membership

All bowlers must be 2025/26 USBC Youth members in good standing AND at least one bowler must be a 2025/26 Elite 8 Member.

Memberships can be purchased at the time of entry or onsite.

USBC Youth memberships are \$4.
Elite 8 Memberships are \$20.

Entry Fee / Deadline Date

Entry Fee is \$60 per team.

\$32 lineage, \$23 scholarships, and \$5 awards/expenses

The early registration deadline is February 1st, 2026.

Early entries **must** include both a completed entry form and full payment. Entries/Payment received after the deadline will have a \$5 per-person late fee.

All late fees will be added to the scholarship fund.

On-Site Registration

Will be allowed on a first come, first served basis.

On-site registration will close 30 minutes before squad times.
(CASH or ZELLE ONLY)

Re-Entries will **not** be charged the late fee.

Divisions and Handicap

1 Division

Handicap will be 90% from 400

Average Verification

- A. Elite 8 tournament average of 9 games or more, as of November 17, 2025.
- B. If A does not apply, use 2024/25 Composite Average of 9 games or more as listed on Bowl.com
- C. If A& B do not apply, use the highest 9 game, certified league average as of January 25, 2026
(Include league standing sheet with entry)
- D. If none of the above apply, bowler will use a 200 average.

(Converted sport shot average will be used if no bowl.com house average is available)

Scholarship Fund

Scholarships will be awarded based on a 1:5 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth Bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament. Scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART (Account #9558).

Format

Teams will consist of 2 Youth bowlers (under 18 as of Aug 1, 2025).

The Alibi tournament allows bowlers to throw out their lowest game.

Bowlers will each bowl 4 games and the top 3 scores for each bowler will count towards their team total.

All games will count towards the bowler's E8 average.

The lane condition will be a house pattern and bowlers will remain on their starting pair.

Lanes will be reoiled between squads.

Bowlers must change partners if bowling both squads.

Junior Gold Qualifier

DCUSBC will be running an optional Junior Gold Qualifier during the 1:30 pm squad. Please see separate entry form for more details.

Bowling Ball Specifications

Alteration of the ball surface may be performed before or during practice only. Balls must be drilled and maintained within USBC guidelines only.

Dress Code / Conduct

Collared shirts or bowling jerseys are required.

Slacks, khakis, shorts, and skorts are allowed.

Shorts & skorts must be at least fingertip length.

Clothing with holes, tight spandex, head gear, or sunglasses will not be permitted. Any exceptions for dress code must be approved by tournament officials.

In order to verify dress code, all bowlers MUST check themselves in.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to striking ball return or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in immediate disqualifications and forfeiture of fees paid. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowler settee area. Bowlers and spectators will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner. Tournament officials will have final discretion on all code / conduct issues.

Any rule not mentioned here will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.
